

Regulations governing the use of boats chartered from the Lake Zurich Navigation Company (ZSG)

1. Attaching / hanging of material

If attaching shelves and/or hanging promotional material, etc. it is not permitted to bore holes. Screws may not be loosened or removed from ceilings or walls anywhere on the boat. Use of screws and the hammering of nails is also not permitted. Already installed hooks may be used.

Gluing or other bonding materials may be used only on condition that they leave no residue and cause no damage. Adhesive strips must be removed completely. In general, nothing may be affixed to the exterior of the boat (bulwark and structures). Attachments with rope or cable fastenings are, however, permitted.

2. Lighting

Lamps and light bulbs may not be removed.

3. Candles

Candles are not permitted on the boats. However, glass-protected LED wind lanterns are allowed and can be ordered from Lake Zurich Gastronomy.

4. Floor surfaces

Floor surfaces on the boats are scratch-sensitive and are to be treated with care. Equipment, boxes, crates, shelves, tools, etc. are not to be dragged along the floor surfaces. Everything must either be carried or transported by rubber-wheeled roll carts or trolleys.

5. Fire extinguishers

The on-board fire extinguishers must be clearly visible and easily accessible at all times.

6. Floor hatches

Floor hatches in all rooms and on all decks must be easily accessible at all times. The same applies to entrance doors to the service areas.

7. Service areas

The cash offices on the boats can be used by the vessel hirers and their personnel only if prior agreement has been obtained with the ZSG. The operation of light switches and other boat equipment is the sole responsibility of ZSG personnel.
