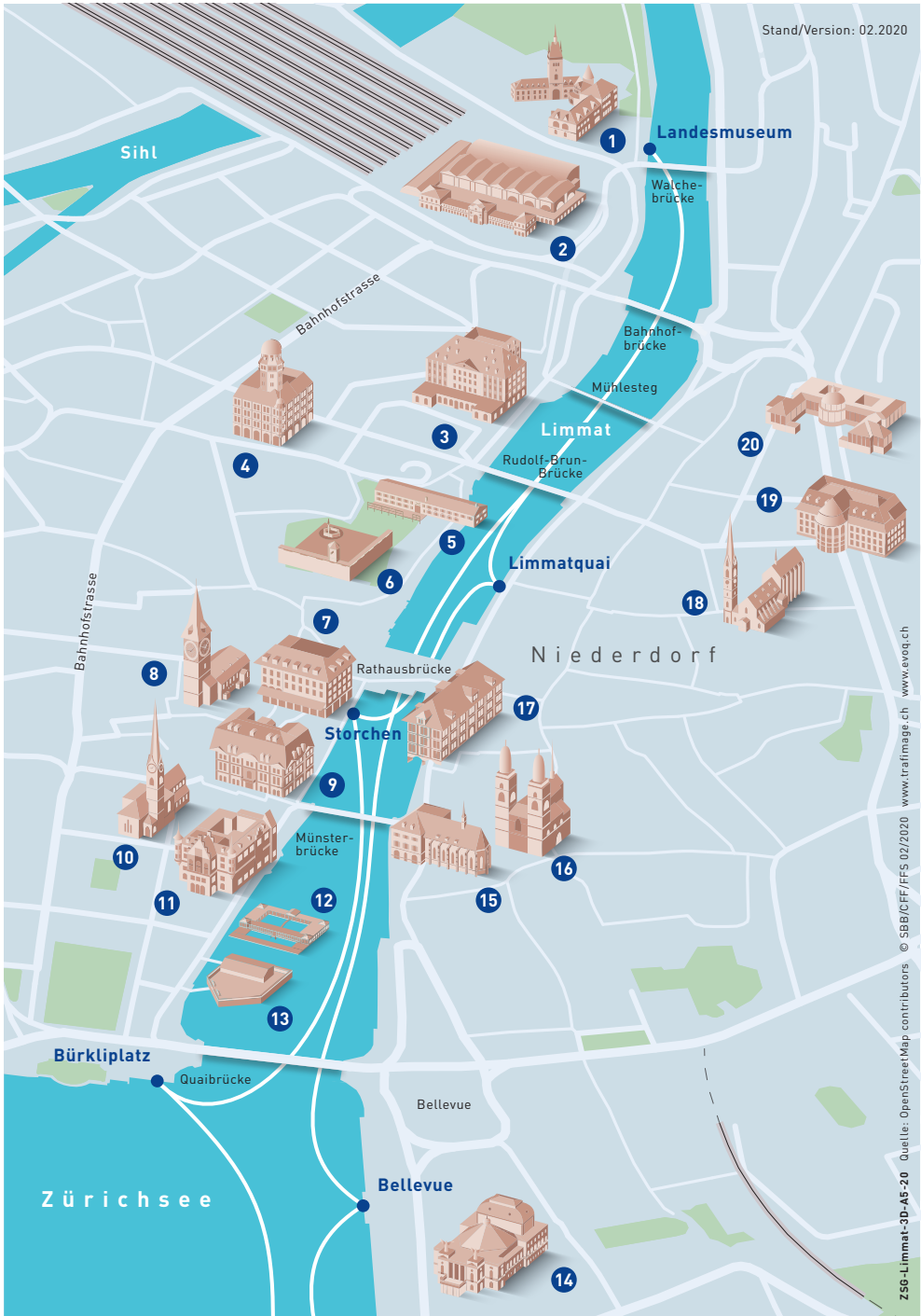

## MINI LAKE CRUISE

EXCURSION TIPS

### AQUARETUM

**Boat station:** Zürich Bürkliplatz  
**Info:** In 2019 the landmark Aquaretum water fountain near the Enge port underwent an extensive update. The fountain is now fine-tuned to the rhythms of our city – a brainchild of visionary Zurich sound architect Andres Bosshard.

### ROTE FABRIK

**Boat station:** Zürich Wollishofen  
**Info:** This former factory is a party venue and alternative cultural centre for art, literature and the theatre. It also comprises a sailing school, children's playschool and the "Ziegel oh Lac" restaurant, renowned for its bolognese.

### LANDIWIESE AND SAFFA ISLAND

**Boat station:** Zürich Wollishofen  
**Info:** The Landiwiese and nearby Saffa Island are firm favourites among Zurich's bathing attractions. A national exhibition dedicated to women was held here in 1958. Every summer an open-air theatre festival now attracts many visitors.

### SEEBAD ZOLLIKON

**Boat station:** Zollikon  
**Info:** Another popular feature of Lake Zurich is this historic lido, not far from the Zollikon landing stage. Constructed symmetrically in 1922 for gender-segregated bathing and swimming, it became an integrated venue in 1969.

### AU PENINSULA WINE MUSEUM

**Boat station:** Halbinsel Au  
**Info:** The Wine Museum on the Au Peninsula offers a fascinating insight into the history of wine growing around the shores of Lake Zurich. Behind the museum is a small vineyard, cultivated by traditional grape-growing methods.

### CHILDREN'S ZOO RAPPERSWIL

**Boat station:** Rapperswil  
**Info:** At Knies children's zoo you can experience animals up close – elephant rides and camel feeding are just two of the many attractions they offer. An experience for young and old!

### UFENAU ISLAND

**Boat station:** Insel Ufenau  
**Info:** Ufenau is Switzerland's largest island not connected to the mainland by a bridge. Since 965 Ufenau has been owned by the Benedictine monastery of Einsiedeln. Well worth a visit – the two medieval churches on the island.

### RAPPERSWIL OLD TOWN

**Boat station:** Rapperswil  
**Info:** The landmark attraction of Rapperswil is its medieval castle. But the town is also famous for its picturesque promenade and rose gardens. Cosy cafes and restaurants also invite visitors to linger longer.

- 1 Swiss National Museum**  
Our country's culture and history.
- 2 Zurich main railway station**  
The largest in Switzerland (1871).
- 3 Urania Police Station**  
Artistically designed entrance hall.
- 4 Urania Observatory**  
See the stars – from the highest wine bar in Zurich.
- 5 Schipfe**  
In the Middle Ages an important trading point for merchandise.
- 6 Lindenhof**  
Ancient Roman site in Zurich – and a beautiful vantage point.
- 7 Hotel Storch**  
5-star hotel with a 650-year history.
- 8 St. Peter's Church**  
Europe's largest clock tower (8.7 metres in diameter).
- 9 Meisen Guild House**  
Historic rococo interior with rare porcelain collection.
- 10 Fraumünster Church**  
Famous for impressive stained glass windows by Chagall and Giacometti.
- 11 Stadthaus**  
Zurich's City Hall and a popular venue for exhibitions.

- 12 Frauenbadi**  
Daytime swimming pool (women only). Public bar in the evening.
- 13 Bauschänzli**  
Once part of the city's fortifications – now a popular beer garden.
- 14 Opera House**  
The Zurich Opera House (1891) also stages ballet productions.
- 15 Water Church**  
Site of the executions of Saints Felix and Regula by the Romans.
- 16 Grossmünster**  
Zurich's renowned landmark church.
- 17 Town Hall**  
Reminiscent of the Renaissance palaces of the early 16th century.
- 18 Predigerkirche**  
13th century church in the style of a Romanesque basilica.
- 19 Zurich University**  
The first state-founded university in Europe (1833).
- 20 ETH Zurich**  
World renowned science, technology and engineering university (1855).

**Boat station:** Zürich Bürkliplatz  
**Info:** From flea to farmers, from art to the choicest cheeses – Bürkliplatz (opposite the ZSG boat station) is the popular venue for open-air markets held at regular intervals during the year.

**Boat station:** Kilchberg  
**Info:** The Lindt Chocolate Museum is a unique new attraction offering fun and fascination for all the family. Highlights include the Lindt Chocolate Shop, the spectacular Chocolate Fountain and also a range of interactive exhibits.

### FIFA WORLD FOOTBALL MUSEUM

**Boat station:** Zürich Bürkliplatz  
**Info:** The FIFA World Football Museum is the home of football history. Over 3000 square metres, it offers a unique insight into the world's most popular sport. Highlight exhibit is the original FIFA World Cup trophy.

### CHINESE GARDEN

**Boat station:** Zürichhorn  
**Info:** The Chinese Garden is a gift from the Chinese metropolis of Kunming, Zurich's twin city. The garden is located by the lakeside promenade and is an inviting oasis of calm in Switzerland's largest city.
